
Utah's Water Future

Local Resident Perspectives on Water Issues in the Salt Lake Valley and Beyond









INTRODUCTION & BACKGROUND

Water is a vital resource for sustaining life in the American West. The availability of water allowed the pioneer settlement of Utah's mountain valleys in the 1800s, and water continues to provide for economic development, population growth, recreational activities and environmental quality.

Our project is designed to learn how households in Utah manage and think about their water. This survey asks questions about your household, water management practices, and concerns, values, and views on a range of water issues.

We have randomly selected neighborhoods and households to represent the diversity of people who live in Utah. Participation in this study is voluntary, but for our results to be scientifically valid, we need as many selected households as possible to complete and return the questionnaire. All information provided will be treated as strictly confidential, and no findings will be released that could identify the identity of any particular respondents. More information about the study and our efforts to protect the interests of our respondents can be found on the Letter of Information included with this survey.

INSTRUCTIONS

Who should fill out the survey? We ask that an adult (18 or over) in each selected household with general knowledge about the household's water use and decisions fill out the survey.

How do I return the survey? Our team should have made arrangements to pick up the survey at a particular time and day. Please put the completed survey in envelope and bag provided and hang it on your doorknob for us to pick up. If you need to schedule a time to pick up the survey, call either of the numbers below.

How do I record my answers? Most questions in this survey will ask you to check a circle to indicate your answer. We ask that you use a dark pen or pencil to place an "X" or " \checkmark " in the space provided (see example below). Some questions provide a space to write in more details. You can always write notes on the survey to clarify your answers where you think it would be helpful to us.
